

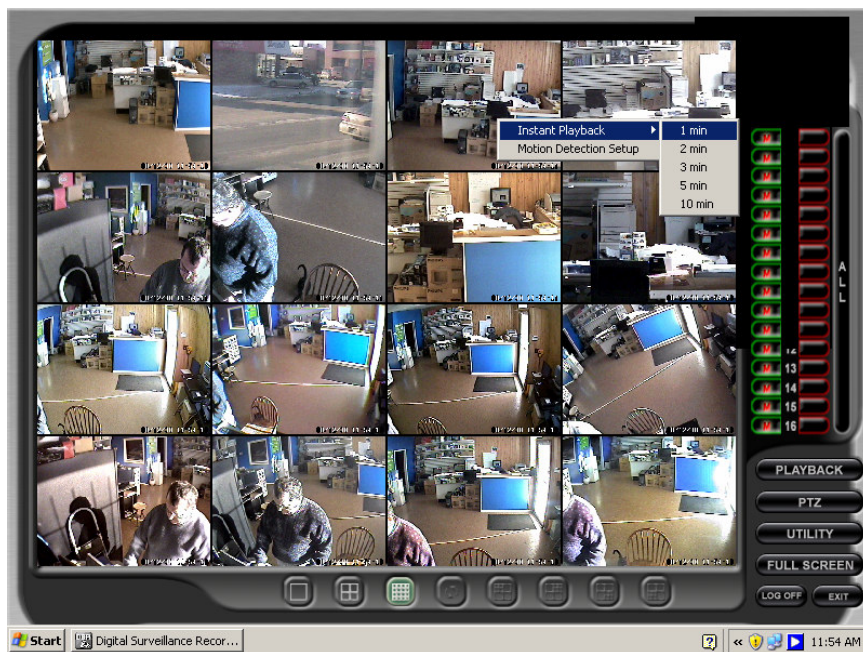

Instant Playback

Instant Playback

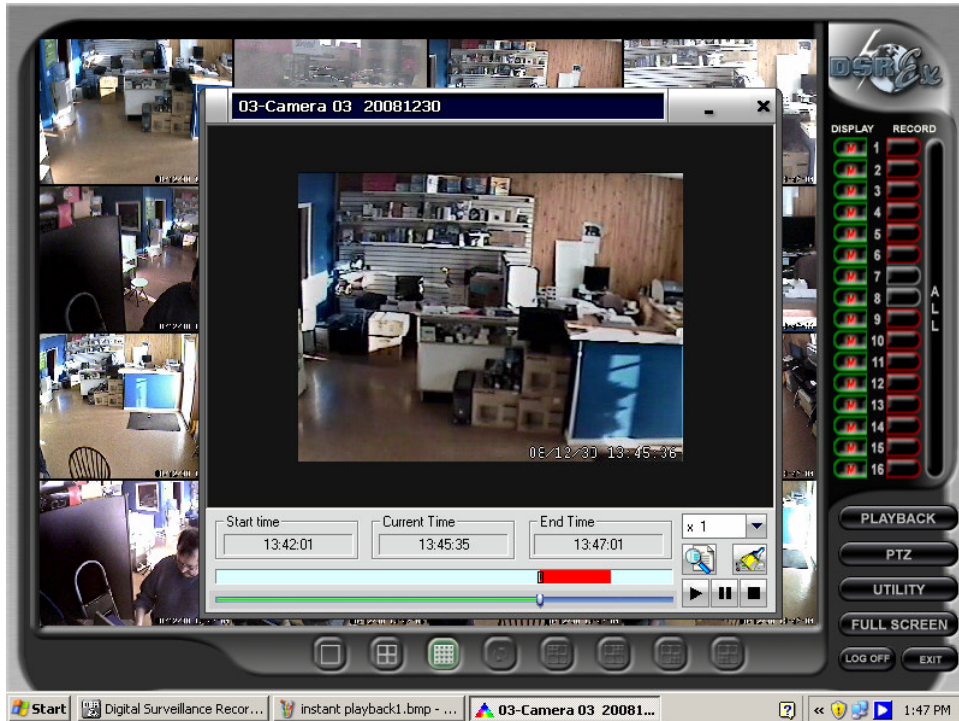
A user can right click over a camera screen and they will see two options, Instant Playback and Motion Detection Setup. (Note that Operator users do not have access to Motion Detection setup and so will only see the Instant Playback option).



Instant Playback contains a sub menu with selections for 1, 2, 3, 5 and 10 minutes. When the user selects a time, a small Playback screen will open with the files from that camera, for the specified time, pre-loaded.:

File Information

The File Information area displays information about the files loaded for the time period selected.

- Start Time and End Time represent the beginning and end of the graphical bar at the bottom. The far left is the Start time and the far right is the End time.
- Current Time shows the time currently playing.
- Video files are represented within this graph depending on their length and the type of recording:
 - Yellow – Instant Recording
 - Green – Scheduled Recording
 - Red – Alarm Recording
 - Blue – Pre-Alarm Recording
 - The small black lines represent the beginning of a video file. The current file playing has a small black square around its mark.
- Use the Position Slider to move within the selected time period

Other Controls



File List

Open the File List to view and mark files loaded for playback:

- Select a file to view a small thumbnail of that file.
- Right click on a file to Preview, Mark for Copy, Mark for Backup, Mark for Delete, Mark for Remark.
- Multiple files can be selected for marking by click holding the mouse and dragging over the files or by holding Ctrl or Alt and selecting files.
- Preview – view the first frame of the file in it's original resolution.
- Mark for Copy, Backup, Delete – User can review and mark files from the list as necessary for each function. Once satisfied that all files have been marked for their respective operations, click on FileKeeping from the main Playback screen to perform the operations.
- Remark – Allows user to add comments to individual video files.
- Clicking on Show Marked Files allows the user to filter the list according to marked files only.



File Keeping - After all files of interest have been marked for Copy, Backup or Delete from the File List window, the FileKeeping window should then be used to perform these operations.
